## **PENTECOST SUNDAY: JUNE 8**

In two weeks, as we gather “all together in one place.” Acts 2:1 we will also celebrate the arrival of the Holy Spirit in our scripture lessons!

Historically and symbolically, Pentecost is related to the Jewish harvest festival of Shavuot, the day that is fifty days (hence its name) after the Exodus during which God gave the Ten Commandments at Mount Sinai. In the Christian church, Pentecost now celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus as described in the Book of Acts, chapter 2. Red symbolizes the “fire” of the Holy Spirit who descended from heaven like a violent wind and gave to each prophetic speech in their native tongues.

So, let’s set our hearts on fire this Sunday and symbolize it in our attire. ***Please plan to wear something “red” on this special day in our church year!***




**SUMMER PICNIC**




**CDC NEWS**




Greetings everyone and welcome to Summer! I personally am excited that summer is here and the Child Development Center is super excited about the great things we have going on this summer. We have four Enrichment Camps which include a fitness-around-the-world camp, a pottery camp, a music camp and an art camp. These camps run Monday through Friday from 9am-12pm and are \$75 per child, per camp. We are also offering our Summer Fun Days program, a relaxing way to keep your children connected with the CDC throughout the summer. This program runs Tuesday through Thursday, also from 9am-12pm and is \$50 per week, per child. 




