Lent 2017: Baring, Sharing, and Preparing

It happened again this year. On the Monday before our Ash Wednesday service this year, I made my annual voyage. I go “down” to this place several times throughout the year, but every year as the Season of Lent begins again I walk down the cellar steps into the stoned-walled, dirt-floored, tomb-like, “basement” beneath our sanctuary to retrieve the wooden cross that will stand in our sanctuary throughout this season of penitence and return. Every year, the “chicken wire” that is stapled on it that allows us to adorn it with the flowers of Easter morning remains. I remove that wire and move the cross to the exit. I chuckle a bit each year as I hoist this central symbol of our faith and ascend the stairs, bearing the cross on my back and wondering who might be seeing me emerge, moving up and out of the cellar, turning left up the ramp and into our sanctuary.

Once in the sanctuary, and a bit more alone, I place the cross just left of the pulpit where the baptismal font most often sits, and I prepare it for all to see in the weeks ahead. I wrap the base with a brown blanket that makes it look like an earthen mound. I then go in search of the purple cloth we drape the cross with and, finally, I place the *Crown of Thorns*, donated by Nita and Paul Culbertson two years ago, on the top. I marvel at how the days can often seem to “drag on,” but how the years fly by. It’s Lent again and we’re intentional again. We are squarely focused on who we are and what we’re supposed to be doing in a way that we haven’t been since (maybe) the Advent season, but surely no other time of the year.

Our Christian life begins in the waters of baptism and ends in Resurrection, but between the “Alpha and Omega” is the journey. On this leg of that journey, we have chosen once again to travel with the church here in Pewee Valley toward the cross and beyond. So, as you all come up out of the cellars of your lives, bearing the crosses of your lives, it is my prayer that you, too, will find a place for them in our common sanctuary - our lives together - to set them down and adorn them for the Lenten journey. Only in this way, with crosses “*bared*” and “*shared*,” may we be “*prepared*” for the Easter morning that is our promise when the journey is through.

See you in church this month. Bring your crosses ...

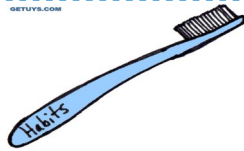

- 10 Band-aids or other adhesive bandage strips

Thanks to you all for your generosity; and thanks to Pastor Joel and Toby for helping to deliver all the items. They shared with me that every month they are assisting around 1,000 people including a lot of children. So, even though Mrs. Tobe's class won the overall prize of an ice cream party, we were all winners because we were able to help others. I also want to mention that along with food, one of their other greatest needs is linens such as sheets, towels, blankets, etc. If you have any extra of these items in your house that are gently used (but do not go out and buy anything!), please consider donating them to this organization. Feel free to bring them to the CDC office at your convenience and I will make sure they find their way to the Pantry.

HAVE YOU ENROLLED YOUR KROGER PLUS CARD? (I thought all caps might grab your attention!) The CDC is slowly moving in the right direction with enrollment in the Kroger Community Rewards Program, going from 13 households enrolled at the beginning of the year to 28 in mid-February.
