Setting Sail on the Eastertide Once Again



From the Desk of Reverend Joel Weible

Immediately after Mary Magdalene "went and announced to the disciples" that she had "seen the Lord" (the end of the scripture we shared again on Easter morning), Jesus appears to the disciples who were locked behind closed doors. He says to them, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you!" It's our turn now.

The 50 days between, and including, Easter and Pentecost are called Eastertide and we use this time in our church life to witness to the Resurrection that we proclaimed on Easter morning. The proclamation of Easter Sunday turns to instruction and demonstration during these days: "Here's what we are to do now that we know that Christ is not 'dead'... and, here's how we are doing it!

In an article from 2017 written by Don Belt for National Geographic entitled "Jesus and the Apostles," Belt writes, "Like billions of other human beings, Jesus of Nazareth, the man, passed through history like a campfire spark, a pinpoint of light here for an instant and then no more." But because of the way he lived and loved, very soon after his brutal death (three days, if you must) those who most closely followed him realized something extraordinary: Jesus was crucified, but Christ is alive! While he was with them, Jesus breathed new life into them. And it is now their turn to be sent into the world to live and to love as Jesus did (John 20:21-22).

Those disciples are us. The tide is right, my friends. The winds of grace that brought us to this time again this year will bear us forward in weeks ahead – and Oh! The Places We'll Go! Read on in this month's Cornerstone, weigh the anchor that's keeping you landbound and catch the Spirit in your own sails. Here's the perfect way to begin again
